ABOUT US

Crook County Fire and Rescue was established in 1882, originally know as Prineville Fire Department.

We have grown from the first fire district covering several city blocks; to a district that now cover just over 400 square miles.

As a team we respond to over 2,000 calls a year. In addition to our Fire District we cover a 3,000 square mile ambulance service area.

There are three stations in our District. We have one in Juniper Canyon, Powell Butte, and our main station in Prineville. We are seeking volunteers in all areas of our District.

If you're looking for a challenging and rewarding way to serve your community, you should look into becoming a volunteer with us. It is a life changing experience that will make you, your family, and your friends proud.

INVOLVEMENT

What we require out of our volunteers is 16 hours a month. In addition to that we require 12 hours of quarterly training throughout the year.

There is a 20 day academy that all volunteers must complete. You will become a NFPA Firefighter I, and a certified first responder. It is a long and challenging academy, but with a volunteer pool of around 40, we would say that it is well worth the challenge.

In addition to the fire and medical responses, we also offer other fields that may be interesting to you, including community involvement with fire prevention activities, such as working with children, wildfire awareness and helping others in protecting their homes, and several other activities that help our community.



REQUIREMENTS

These are the requirements to become a volunteer with us:

- Good physical condition
- Have a valid Oregon Drivers License
- No criminal history
- No chronic use of alcohol or other illicit drugs
- 18 years of age or older

IDEAL CANDIDATES

- Reside in our Fire District
- Self motivator
- Knowledge of our area
- Have a sense of belonging to this community

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

There is around 120 hours of class and lab time. The academy will run through several consecutive weekends, and also include some weekday evening.

HOW TO APPLY

We have an academy once a year. Applications are due by January 1st of the year of the academy.

The next step is to then go through an interview with our volunteer president and 4 other members of the department.

Individuals who have been selected to move on will then be made aware of specific academy dates. All individuals must complete the entire academy before moving on to the ranking of a volunteer.
